During the 2014-15 school year ninety-five schools in the Jefferson County Public School (JCPS) District participated in the Community Eligibility (CE) pilot under the National School Lunch Program. The CE provision is directed toward schools with a high percentage of economically disadvantaged students. Under CE, all students receive a breakfast/lunch at no charge for the entire school year.

Beginning in 2023-24, All of JCPS is CE! This means all students are eligible for free breakfast and lunch through the Community Eligibility (CE) program, regardless of their family's income.
