Let's Get Started

JCPS has **89 elementary schools**, all of which focus on core subjects like reading, writing, math, science, and social studies while also introducing students to a variety of other subjects, such as the arts, technology, and world languages.

To better predict your student's educational path, JCPS is moving away from "clusters" and now designates elementary school zones by high school networks. Each elementary school is grouped into **1 of 15 feeder patterns**—groups of 3 to 8 JCPS elementary schools located within a geographic area connected to a specific JCPS high school. JCPS guarantees your student a seat at one of the schools in their designated zone, determined by your student's home address.

While most elementary school students choose to attend one of the schools in their zone, JCPS has other programs to best match your student's learning style or interests. We offer a variety of elementary magnet schools and magnet programs—many of which are nationally recognized or focus on a specialized area, such as performing arts—as well as Traditional Magnet Schools that emphasize back-to-basics learning in a highly structured environment. **JCPS also offers students living in the Choice Zone an option to attend school close to home or farther away.**

Review Options and Select Preference

Registration Process

- All students new to JCPS must register with the district before applying for school.
- You may register your student for school regardless of immigration status and/or a fixed, regular, and adequate nighttime residence. For more information, contact the Office of Access and Opportunity at **(502) 485-3650**.





After You Register

After you register, JCPS will verify your information and send you an email to complete your application, which can take up to two business days. Incoming kindergartners and/or new students to JCPS may then apply to schools within their zone. To find out which zone you're located in, call the JCPS Demographics Office at **(502) 485-3050** or use the online JCPS SchoolFinder search tool. (See page 4 to scan QR code.)

Important to note: Although you can register at any time with a Jefferson County address, it's important to reference the on-time application window. Late applications will be processed and assignments are made based on school capacity.

Apply

Application Process

All elementary students completing an application must rank the schools within their zone in order of preference. If you live in the Choice Zone, you must select between your close-to-home or farther-away options before you begin ranking. JCPS keeps siblings together in elementary school zones. The district also considers parental choice, space, a student's home address, and the diversity of the student body when placing students at schools. Due to capacity constraints, not all families can or will receive their first school choice.

Magnet Application Information

- Students may submit one magnet application per year.
- Submitting a magnet application doesn't guarantee admission, and submitting false information will void an application.
- Waiting lists are not kept from year to year.
- Magnet applications can only be edited during the on-time application period.
- Siblings of current or former magnet school students do not receive preference in the application process, but those who share the same date of birth (twins, triplets, etc.) are treated as one application. However, parents must submit a separate application for each student.
- Students must be a resident of Jefferson County to attend a magnet school or magnet program. If families are relocating, contact the Office of School Choice at **(502) 485-6250**.

You need to apply if:

- Your student has never attended a JCPS school.
- Your student is entering kindergarten.
- Your student has had a change of address.
- Your student is applying for a magnet school or magnet program.

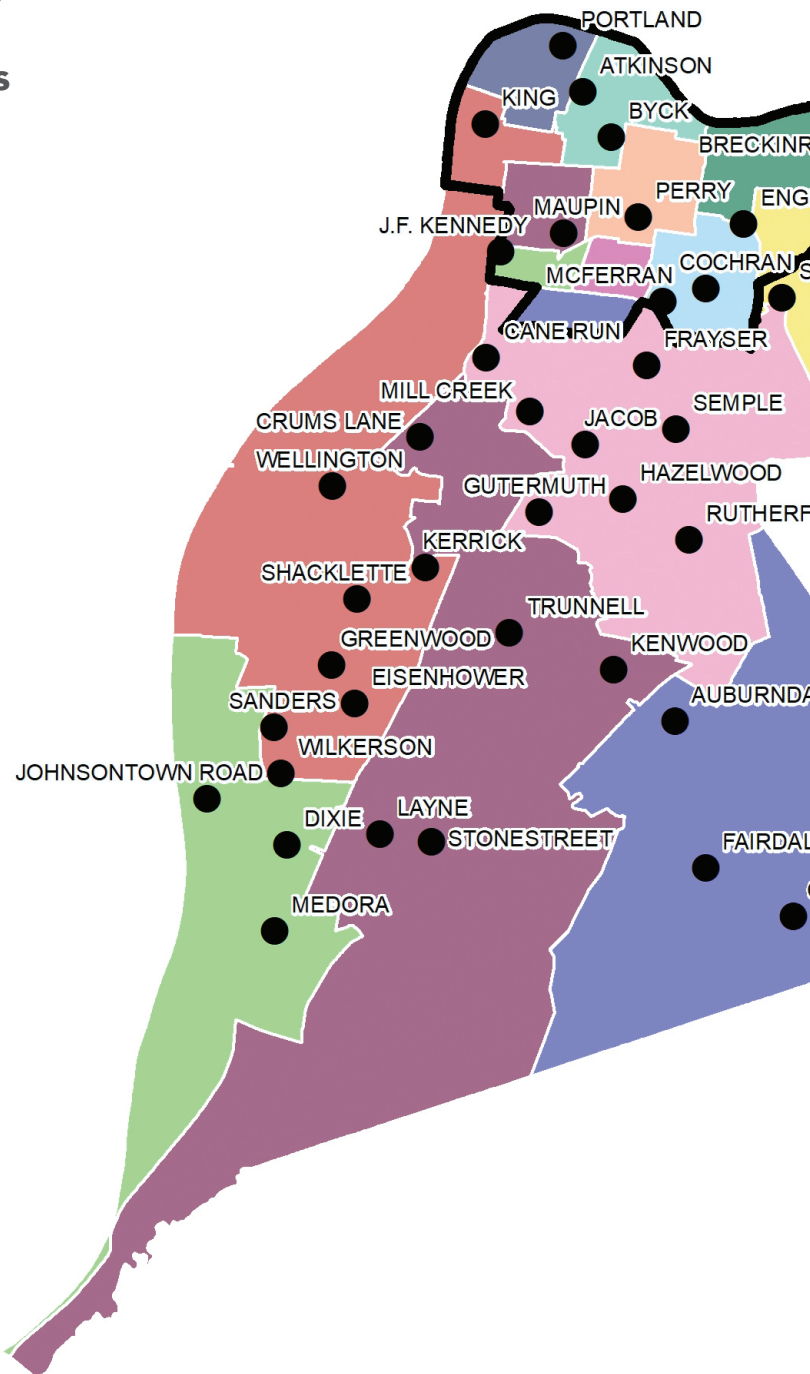
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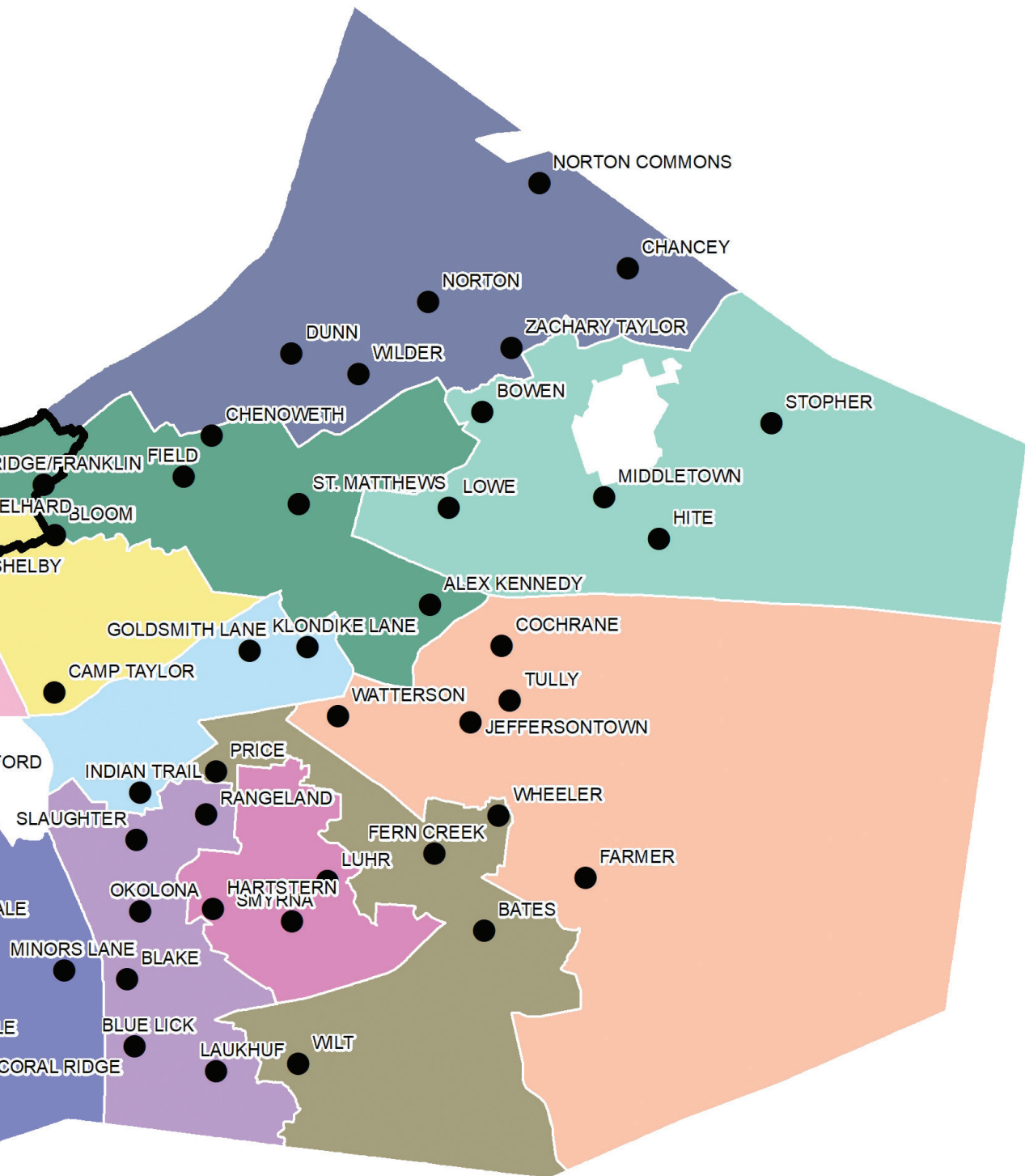
What Is a Zone?

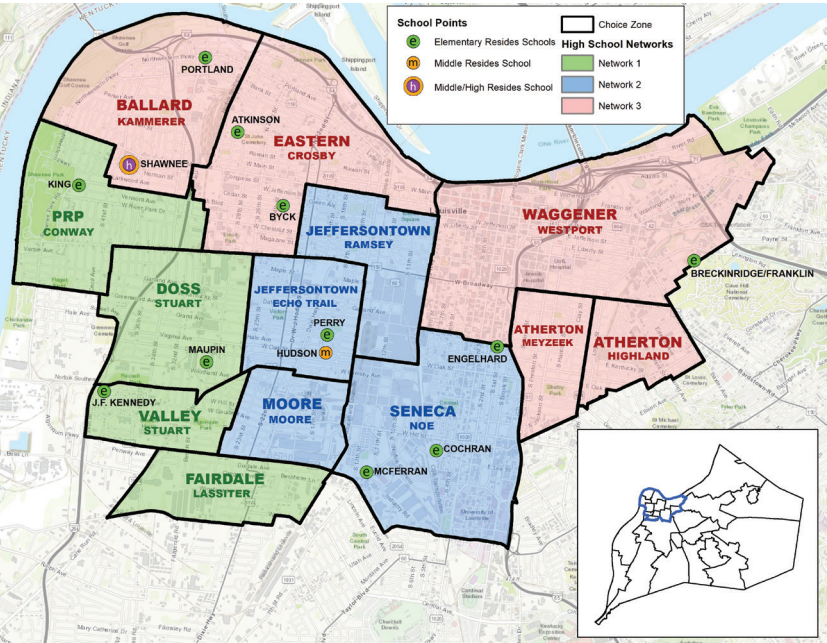

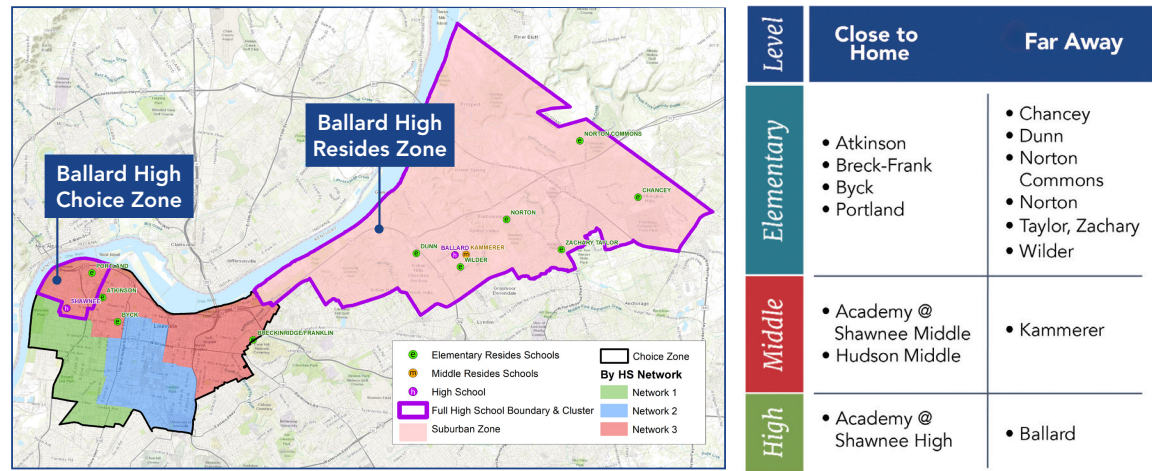

Magnet programs have a specific theme and focus or provide a specialized learning environment.

- **All students applying for elementary magnet programs during the application period will be included in a lottery for admission.** No additional selection criteria or materials are required for elementary magnet program admission. If you're not initially accepted at one of the schools you've listed, you will be notified in the spring of your place on the waiting list.
- **Siblings of current or former magnet program students do not receive preference in the application process.** However, applications for siblings who share the same birth date (twins, triplets, etc.) who are applying to a program will be treated as one application. Parents/Guardians must still submit separate applications for each student.

A: JCPs offers a school choice system that lets parents apply to the school that best meets their student's needs and academic interests. (See the School Choice QR code above.) JCPs also offers students living in the Choice Zone the option to attend school close to home or far away.

Q: How many magnet choices can I submit for my student?

A: Parents may select up to two magnet choices on the application.

Q: How can I change the application to a different school or program?

A: An online application can be changed until **December 20, 2024**. Changes are not permitted once the application period closes.

Q: How do I find out my student's resides school?

A: Use the SchoolFinder tool on the JCPs website to find your student's school. (See the SchoolFinder QR code above.)

Q: I have applied, but my address has changed. What do I do?

A: Call the Office of School Choice at **(502) 485-6250** to determine if the change of address will impact your student's application. Some schools or programs have boundaries. A change of address could mean your student, if accepted, would have a different school assignment.

Q: When and how will I find out about my student's assignment?

A: Students who apply during the application period will be notified by letter, email, or phone of the status of their application by **April 2025**.

Q: I missed the magnet application period. What are my options?

A: You may submit a magnet application after **December 20, 2024**, but the application will only be considered if the school has openings for additional students. Students may always attend a school within their zone. (See **School Choice** QR code.)

Q: I don't live in Jefferson County right now but will be moving there before school begins. Can I submit a magnet application for my student?

A: You may submit a magnet application in order for your student to be considered for your school choice option. Students may always attend a school within their zone. You must provide proof of residence in Jefferson County before your student can enroll in a JCPS school. Call the Office of School Choice at **(502) 485-6250** for more information.

Q: I'll be moving to Jefferson County after school begins. What are the magnet options for my student?

A: Students who relocate to Jefferson County after the start of the 2025-26 school year can inquire about a magnet school option at the time of their arrival through **December 31, 2025**, but options may be limited. Students may always attend a school within their zone. Call the Office of School Choice at **(502) 485-6250** for more information.

Q: Does JCPS offer before-/after-school childcare programming?

A: Yes, the Child Enrichment Program (CEP) is offered through a partnership with the YMCA. (See the CEP Program QR code.) Contact the YMCA for more information.
